President & Chief Executive Officer

Bud Crumlish was appointed president and chief executive officer of CTG in July 2016. Previously he was a senior vice president responsible for the Company’s IT and other staffing services, a position he had held since 2001. Bud joined the Company in 1990 and held several positions in the finance department before being named financial controller for the Company’s staffing business in 1996.
