President & Chief Executive Office

Filip Gydé was appointed President and Chief Executive Officer effective March 1, 2019. Previously he was Executive Vice President, General Manager and President for CTG's European operations since May 2018. Mr. Gydé was named Senior Vice President and General Manager of CTG's European operations in 2000 and held that position until the death of the Company's CEO in October 2014, when he was named Interim Executive Vice President of operations, assisting the Interim CEO in overseeing CTG's worldwide operations. In April 2015 he returned to his aforementioned role. Mr. Gydé was named Managing Director for Luxembourg in 1999 and Managing Director for Belgium in 1996, after holding positions of increasing responsibility since joining CTG in 1987. Mr. Gydé earned a degree in civil engineering from Ghent University and a master's in business administration from the University of Antwerp.
